#### 1 VALE TERRY O'NEILL

The Eltham Rugby Union Football Club extends its deepest condolences to the family and friends of Terry O'Neill, a much-loved member whose leadership and passion helped shape the club's early years.

Terry was both a dedicated player and a committed volunteer during the club's first decade, captaining the inaugural team in 1971 and later serving as player-coach. His efforts culminated in Eltham's first Premiership flag in 1980. Known for his tenacity and camaraderie, Terry's influence on and off the field helped define the spirit of Eltham Rugby.

After moving to Ballarat with his wife, Margaret, Terry remained a proud supporter of the club. He passed away peacefully on 17 September 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

Terry's legacy endures through the generations of players who continue to embody the values he helped establish.





2025 has been a landmark year for **Eltham Rugby Union Football Club**, one that reflects what can be achieved when commitment, purpose, and community spirit come together. From our grassroots programs to the triumphant return of our senior team, on-field success has been complemented by significant financial commitments to upgrade club facilities including the long-desired refurbishment of our Bridge St ground.

#### A Season to Remember

After a year's absence, our Seniors are back! With more than 50 registered players, Eltham's return to senior competition rugby culminated in a Conference Championship Grand Final victory. This win was more than just a result; it reflected a year of concerted effort from our Senior Rugby Co-ordinator, Roger Iacobucci, and our committee, coaches, players, and volunteers to have a senior team back in Eltham colours. Our Junior teams represented the club with pride; our U12 side made the semi-finals of their competition while our combined Melton-Eltham U16 team were brave Grand Final runners-up. We also participated in the roll-out of Rugby Australia's new Get into Rugby program that provides entry-level participation in rugby for children aged 4-7 years.

#### Our Role in the Community

Eltham Rugby continues to forge strong links with the local sporting community. We work closely with **Rugby Victoria**, **Nillumbik Shire Council**, and our partners-in-rugby clubs including **Melton**, **Maroondah**, **Kiwi Hawthorn**, and **Northern** to build strong pathways for participation.





We have initiated new relationships with local schools such as **Concord School** and **Catholic Ladies College**, where we help introduce rugby to new players and create inclusive opportunities for students of all abilities.

The introduction of our new **Girls' Rugby Program** has been a stand-out achievement for the club, the result of a sustained effort by our junior co-ordinators and coaches to reach out into the community to promote girls' rugby, and with the support of Rugby Victoria and State government funding. These initiatives are helping us to nurture the next generation of female players and promote equality in sport — a key focus for Eltham Rugby moving forward.

Beyond sport, our programs build confidence, leadership, and lifelong friendships. This commitment to people, not just performance, is why families continue to join and stay with our club year after year.

#### Highlights of 2025

2025 has been full of milestones that remind us why we love this game:

- The attendance at our Come & Try Day exceeded expectations, introducing dozens of new players and families to rugby and the Eltham club.
- Our International Women's Day celebration recognised the ongoing contribution and leadership of women at our club.
- The inaugural President's Cup was a wonderful celebration of our junior rugby season in a brilliant showcase of community spirit and sportsmanship.
- The Josh Davis Memorial Day gave us a heartfelt opportunity to honour a muchloved teammate and celebrate the bonds that make rugby so meaningful.
- A once-in-a-lifetime experience for several of our juniors who played on the pitch before the British and Irish Lions games when they were in Melbourne and Daithi Loughlin who got to be a part of the guard of honour.
- And our club proudly launched its Eltham Rugby Lifeblood Team, encouraging members to give blood and plasma to save lives, a true reflection of our values off the field.

#### **Building for the Future**

The support of our local council and the State government continue to play a significant role for us to achieve both current and future club goals. Through the dedication of our Committee and Treasurer, **Sylvia Metcalfe**, we secured funding that will transform our facilities and improve player experience at every level. The **changing room renovations**, that begin in November 2025, will be a key step in delivering modern, inclusive facilities, while the **ground redevelopment project** scheduled for late 2026 will provide an elite-standard playing surface that should ensure we will have unrestricted access to our ground during the vagaries of the Melbourne winter!

#### **Governance and Leadership**

This year, our Committee welcomed three new members — Alicia Loughlin, Isabel Sprackman, and Alana Su'a — who have brought fresh energy and professional expertise to our leadership group. Under Alicia's guidance as our club Secretary, we introduced new policies and procedures that promote consistency, accountability, and transparency across all areas of the club, including communications, child safety, and volunteer engagement. This has been a major undertaking, and Alicia's efforts were acknowledged by being selected as the club's Jim Speight Club Volunteer of the Year. Alana and Isabel, our Junior Co-Coordinators, have done a remarkable job in negotiating the challenges and demands that come with rolling out the Junior rugby program, with the added responsibility of introducing the new, untried Get Into Rugby initiative at Eltham. Alana has been tireless in forging the links that have seen the emergence of girls' rugby at our club this year.



We also completed a **new draft Constitution**, which will be presented to members at this year's AGM. This document modernises our governance framework, ensuring we remain compliant, inclusive, and well-positioned for growth.

Looking to next season and beyond, our biggest challenge remains **deepening engagement** with our rugby community, ensuring every member feels connected and part of the club's continued journey. In particular, we need volunteers to feel confident to take on Committee roles, without whom the future will be placed at risk.

#### **3** TREASURER'S REPORT

The 2025 financial year is once again in surplus through responsible planning, careful management and community support, ensuring that Eltham Rugby remains in a strong financial position.

Our surplus of \$16,549 was a small increase from the previous year (see Summary of the Profit and Loss Statements), and resulted in the club's total assets of \$148,106 at the end of September 2025. This amount comprises Bendigo Bank totals of \$124,397 and \$19,307 stock on hand (see Balance Sheet). Given our positive financial status, the Committee invested in new furniture for the clubhouse at the start of the year.

#### Investment in Seniors' Rugby

A significant milestone this year was **the revival of the Senior Rugby program**, supported by substantial investment through subsidising the seniors' registrations (with special thanks to Roger lacobucci from TreesRUs and Tom Navanua), equipment, uniforms, and coaching. With over 50 registered players, the program's success has strengthened club identity and contributed significantly to a sense of community spirit in the club.

As a result of this investment, our expenditure on rugby activities increased markedly as can be seen in the Summary of the Profit and Loss Statement with further details provided in note 1.

#### Successful Grants and Funding

The club was awarded multiple grants, including:

- Change Our Game Grant (State Government) \$5,000 to support girls' participation. This grant funded touch rugby sessions at Concord and Catholic Ladies College through Rugby Victoria. This grant, as well as subsidies provided by the club for registrations means that there is now a vibrant girls' touch training program at Eltham Rugby.
- Sporting Club Grants Program (State Government) \$3,185 for first aid training and strapping. A total of 17 members attended first aid training with a further member participating in strapping training.
- Australian Sports Foundation Active Kids Grant \$2,990 to fund new playing kits for 30 girls. This grant ensures we have training tops, shorts and jerseys that are gender-specific to support girls' participation in rugby.
- Ongoing support from Nillumbik Shire Council for ground and change room redevelopment. As part of Council's successful bid to upgrade the ground, the club has committed and allocated \$50,000 (most likely to be spent in 2027 financial year) towards the overall cost, estimated to be around \$1.2million. The club may also contribute to the renovations of the change room to occur this month depending on the final cost.

These grants represent more than financial wins, they reinforce our club's inclusive values and our reputation as a well-run community organisation.



## 3 TREASURER'S REPORT

#### Sponsorship, Donations and Fundraising

Sponsorship remained steady, with local businesses supporting our programs, uniforms, and events. Many thanks to Jim's Test and Tag, Point Blue, King Apparel, Le Pine Funerals, TreesRUs, Xtermite, Diamond Valley Trophy Centre, Pizza Margherita, Bolton Deli and Lower Plenty Bottlemart. We're truly grateful to our amazing sponsors, their support helps our community sport thrive.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to the Davis family for their generous donation of \$5,000 to the Josh Davis Memorial Fund. Their support will open doors for aspiring players, helping to create new opportunities as they arise.

Christmas tree sales, BBQs on match days and bar sales throughout the year (showing a profit of \$23,372 compared with \$8,424 in the previous year) continued to be strong revenue streams.

The Christmas tree sales are the biggest fundraiser, and last year we made a profit of \$36,878 - another fantastic effort. Thanks to this fundraiser, our club is able to subsidise activities for all and continually enhance our clubhouse facilities for everyone to enjoy. I encourage each and every one of you to get involved.

## 5 SENIOR RUGBY REPORT

From not having a senior team in 2024 to winning the Conference Championship in 2025, this season will go down as one of the most remarkable chapters in Eltham Rugby's proud history. From an uncertain pre-season start – a handful of lads, a couple of props and some "unknowns" – momentum grew as the season unfolded, built on self-belief, brotherhood and determination. Key to this was the return of Tom Navanua, our 2014 Premiership-winning coach, as Head Coach, bringing his tactical knowledge, calm confidence and a commitment to player development. As assistant coach, Ari Su'a was relentless in training the boys throughout the season, especially in preparing our forward pack, while the addition of Anare "Rayza" Kovialu to the coaching staff brought us another layer of professionalism and experience. As the squad grew to 53 registered players, team manager Jack Welch ensured that every player felt part of the mission and got their opportunity on match day.

An unexpected first-round loss to Monash University was, in hindsight, perhaps the reality check we needed, removing any overconfidence about the season ahead. A refocussed side then put together a string of nine successive victories, combining run-away wins with last-minute, get-out-of jail "escapes", before suffering only the second defeat of the season, at Casey, in Round 13. At the end of the regular season, Eltham were Minor Premiers. A reflection of the spirit and camaraderie of our squad was the support shown by those when not selected to play, in turning up at training and games to support those who have.

The Preliminary Final against Ballarat Rugby Club was a nail-biter. In the dying minutes, when it mattered most, Eltham found a way to dig deep and come away with a narrow 28-24 win that had every supporter on their feet.

And so came the ultimate challenge — the Grand Final against Casey Rugby Club, the very side that had beaten us just weeks earlier. It was a true test of character and courage. Both teams gave everything, every tackle and every ruck fought like it was the last. Bodies were battered, and nerves were tested, both on and off the field — but Eltham stood firm, coming away with a 22-14 victory to be crowned 2025 Conference Championship Winners. The joy, relief, and pride were shared not just by the players, but by every coach, volunteer, and supporter who had walked the journey with them. This was more than a championship. It was proof of what can happen when a group of people commit to something bigger than themselves — when mateship, belief, and hard work meet opportunity.

## **6** JUNIOR RUGBY REPORT



Our junior program continues to grow in both numbers and enthusiasm. 2025 saw significant growth from the 2024 season, with new players joining across every age group and a renewed sense of energy throughout the club.

The Get Into Rugby program flourished this season, with 19 children aged seven and under training regularly on Wednesday evenings. Of these, six officially registered through Rugby Victoria's Saturday Get Into Rugby program, demonstrating the strength of our grassroots engagement and the dedication of our volunteer coaches. These sessions have become a lively and welcoming entry point for new families discovering rugby for the first time.

The U11s welcomed six new players and displayed outstanding resilience, teamwork, and camaraderie throughout the season. Week after week, their determination and enthusiasm were a highlight of the junior program.

Our U12s had a fantastic year, reaching the semi-finals after a strong and consistent season. Their growth, discipline, and teamwork reflected the values that make Eltham Rugby so special.

Collaboration with neighbouring clubs ensured that every child could play. The U8/U9s merged with Maroondah, forming a fun, inclusive team that developed confidence and friendships both on and off the field. 


